6.2 Strategic/Perspective plan development and deployment

MSS's Arts, Commerce and Science College, Ambad has prepared a strategic plan.  Graduation in the subjects.
- The parents of girl students, who were not willing to send their wards out of the station to complete the higher education study, got a facility at local level. So, most of the girl students could complete their post-Graduation in the subject Arts, Commerce and Science.

2. Health awareness by NSS unit

- 1. To organize Seven days NSS camp has being organized by college in Khapardev Hivra village
- 2. To create awareness about health issue in villages peoples.
- 3. To improve health standard of village.

Response
